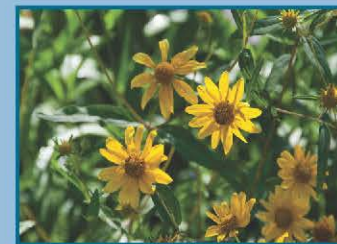

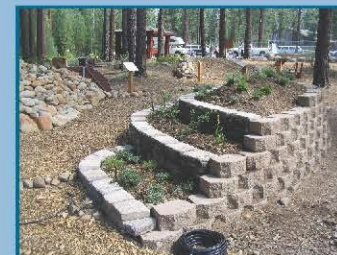

a work in progress, establishing a vital and permanent educational legacy for all Tahoe residents and visitors.

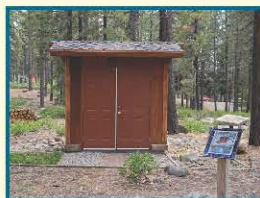


Site Description:

The North Lake Tahoe Demonstration Garden, located at Sierra Nevada College, features Tahoe native and adapted trees, shrubs and flowers. Demonstrations of Best Management

Practices (BMPs) include slope terracing, dripline treatments, permeable paving, driveway drains, and stormwater infiltration techniques that show local residents attractive ways to landscape that help preserve lake clarity and forest health.

Also in the garden are exhibits of vegetable gardening, defensible space, turf and native grasses, and a butterfly garden.



Education is a central feature of the garden, and a variety of classes and workshops provide information on gardening topics.

Green Thumb Classes

are 5:30-6:30

Wednesdays June through July.

Class topics include container gardening, raised-bed vegetable gardening, lake friendly landscaping, high altitude gardening with natives, and more...
